- FRIDAY (23 APRIL):
 - 45° OVERNIGHT LOW, SLIGHT BREEZE BECOMING GUSTY (15 MPH)
- SATURDAY (24 APRIL):
 - 70° HIGH / 48° LOW, WINDY WITH GUSTS UP TO 23 MPH. **HIGH @ the Lake is 64°**
- SUNDAY (25 APRIL):
 - 73° HIGH, WINDY WITH GUSTS UP TO 15 MPH

ALWAYS PLAN FOR 15 DEGREES COLDER THAN FORCAST

MINIMUM STANDARD PACKING LIST

- ☐ Class A & B Uniform (including Boonie, Scout Belt, Olive Green Shorts/Pants, Black Socks)
- ☐ **Face Masks – 2 REQUIRED**
- ☐ Sleeping Bag (temperature appropriate)
- ☐ Sleeping Pad
- ☐ **Tent & ground cover** ← If you own a 1 or 2 person tent, please Bring it and keep it in the car you are driving to camp in.
- ☐ Head Lamp
- ☐ Spare Batteries
- ☐ Refillable Water Bottle, Canteen, and/or Hydration Bladder
- ☐ **Day Pack - (backpack w/wide shoulder straps) – REQUIRED** to tote gear & lunch to the Lake
- ☐ Changes of Clothes (weather appropriate – It will be colder than last campouts and Windy)
- ☐ Beanie/Head Scarf
- ☐ Jacket (weather appropriate)
- ☐ Hiking Boots with good socks for hiking
- ☐ Personal Medication
- ☐ Mess Kit
- ☐ **Camp Chair - REQUIRED**
- ☐ Sunscreen & Chapstick
- ☐ **Small bottle of hand sanitizer - REQUIRED**
- ☐ Rain Gear
- ☐ Personal Toiletries (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- ☐ ScoutBook with EXTRA PEN and PENCIL (REQUIRED)

OUTING-SPECIFIC ITEMS

- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Pocket Knife (REQUIRED if you own one)
- ☐ Needle nose pliers, multi-tool or hook removal tool – optional
- ☐ Old cloth rag/wash cloth – something to wipe fishy stuff on
- ☐ Fishing Pole and Reel

Tackle Box specific items:

- ☐ **PRINTED COPY OF YOUR FISHING LICENSE**
- ☐ Hooks pre-tied, hook sizes between 6 and 10
- ☐ Split Shot sinkers (not lead) – variety of weights
- ☐ Snap Swivels
- ☐ Bobbers – optional
- ☐ Extra fishing line – optional
- ☐ Fishing net – optional (bring one if you have one)

Bait:

- ☐ Scout choice: worms, corn, salmon eggs, hot dogs, or Power Bait (Walmart) are all options



Live worms can be purchased from the Lake store, so bring some extra cash if you intend to fish with worms and get them there.

!!!!!! IMPORTANT PACKING INSTRUCTION FOR YOUR ROD & REEL BELOW

Reels and rods need to be prepared with the line on the reel (not threaded through the eyelets) and secured without a hook on them.

All sections of the rod should be secured together so during transport they do not get separated.
